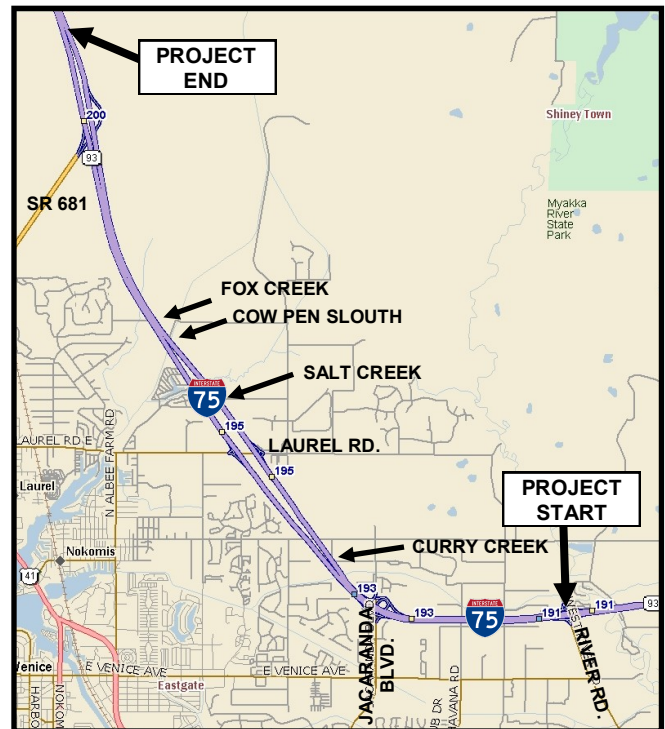

Project Description:

The Florida Department of Transportation will be making roadway improvements on I-75 from north of North River Road to north of State Road 681 in Sarasota County. The improvements under this contract consist of:

- Widening of I-75 from north of River Road to north of State Road 681 from 4 to 6 lanes (adding lanes toward the median)
- Realignment of I-75 southbound lanes from north of Cow Pen Slough to Laurel Road
- Construction of new southbound bridges over Cow Pen Slough and Salt Creek and widening of bridges over Curry Creek and Fox Creek
- Improvements to Laurel Road, Jacaranda Boulevard and River Road.



What to Expect During Construction:

- Motorists can anticipate both daytime and nighttime construction work. Nighttime lane closures will take place between 8 p.m. and 5 a.m.

Please note that RoadWatch notifications will be issued prior to all lane closures, ramp closures and detours. Please check the project Web site for updates.
