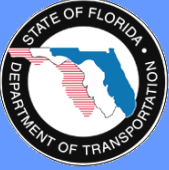

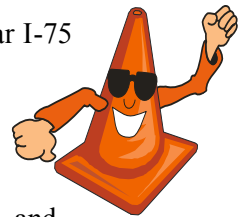

INTERCHANGE IMPROVEMENTS AT I-75 AND LAUREL ROAD:

The Florida Department of Transportation will be making interchange improvements at Laurel Road and I-75 beginning Wednesday, April 20, 2011 as part of the I-75 widening project from north of River Road to north of State Road 681 in Sarasota County. Weather permitting, widening improvements are expected to be complete in summer 2011. Milling (removal of asphalt) and resurfacing, drainage improvements and signalization are expected to be complete by the summer of 2012. The improvements (FIGURE 1) at this interchange consist of:

- Widening I-75 southbound off-ramp at Laurel Road to allow for double right turn lanes
- Widening I-75 northbound off-ramp at Laurel Road to allow for double left turn lanes
- Extending left turn lanes on Laurel Road at the approach to I-75 southbound on-ramp
- Widening Laurel Road to allow for double left turn lanes at the approach to I-75 northbound on-ramp
- Milling (removal of asphalt) and resurfacing of Laurel Road near I-75
- Drainage improvements and signalization



WHAT TO EXPECT DURING CONSTRUCTION:

Motorists can anticipate both daytime and nighttime construction work. Nighttime work will take place between the hours of 8 p.m. and 5 a.m. Motorists can anticipate temporary lane closures, shifting traffic from two lanes to one, on Laurel Road during both daytime and nighttime hours.
